"The Meaning of a Merit Mark"

The Merit Mark Committee has the honor, privilege, and responsibility of preparing merit mark recommendations for those Active and Family members who have made substantial efforts on behalf of our Squadron during the calendar year 2023.

After earning five Mertt Marks a member becomes known is a Senior Member and upon earning 25 Merit Marks & Merit Mark is awarded by the Chief Commander to US75 members who have the furthered interests, programs, and objectives of USPS, its districts, and its squadrons. Members are limited to one Merit Mark per year. When a merit mark recommendation is approved, the Chief Commander 188008 8 certificate to the recipient, who I8 then entitled to wear 8 special merit mark insignia on his/her USPS uniform.

After earning 5 Merit Marks, a member becomes known as a senior Member, and upon earning 25 Merit Marks, the member is designated a Life Member and is exempt from paying dues.

#### VESSEL SAFETY CHECK (VSC)



A major component of a fun filled outing is a reliable boat which has all the necessary equipment operating property. A free vessel safety check (VSC) is an important safe-guard, and our certified examiners will be happy to perform the check for you. There are no negative consequences if you don't pass. Our goal is simply to help make boating as safe as possible for you, your family and your friends, through education.

The United States Power Squadrons and the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary are partners in this valuable program offered to the boating public. All examiners are certified and trained on the latest requirements. The Vessel Safety Check is similar to the review that is performed by the U.S. Coast Guard if you are boarded, except that it is the results.

#### Our Vessel Safety Examiners will perform a 15 point safety check which includes:

**Display of Numbers** Personal Flotation Devices (PFD) Fire Extinguishers Backfire Flame Control Pollution Placard Navigation Rules

- Registration/Documentation Sound Producing Devices MAR POL Track Placard State and/or Local Requirements
- Visual Distress Signals (VDS) Ventilation Navigation Lights Marine Sanitation Devices Overall Vessel Condition
