The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Minutes from the previous meeting are available in the Beachcomber. Minutes were approved with no changes.

Executive Officer Report:

<u>Vessel Safety Report-</u> P/C Don Roman reported that new decals are in. We have six examiners and need more. We have completed 10 VSCs so far this year. Jeff will take a group to the island to do more on Saturday, April 15.
